

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQS)

Does the AGSA offer bursaries?

Yes, we offer bursaries based on academic excellence. Applications are open annually between 15 August and 15 September, covering full tuition fees, books, accommodation, and a monthly allowance. Minimum requirements: Matric - 60% in English and Maths; 1st-2nd year for 3rd year studies - 60% average on core modules; 3rd year for CTA - 55% average on core modules.

What are the minimum qualifications needed to join the AGSA?

You need to have completed CTA to join us. Subsequent to a successful interview process, a contract will be provided in your CTA, subject to completion of CTA.

Can I start my articles and study CTA part-time?

Our primary intake is for candidates who have successfully completed their CTA. Subject to leadership approval we may allow part-time CTA studies for new candidates under different programmes.

Do I need any work experience to join the AGSA?

No, graduates are welcome to apply for entry-level positions with us, however, relevant work experience may be beneficial.

What opportunities are available for graduates at AGSA?

Graduates can apply for entry-level positions, such as an Audit Trainee, Data Analyst trainee, ICT internships and more. You may also get the opportunity to participate in our other structured training programmes.

What kinds of skills and attributes are valued by the AGSA?

We value individuals who are analytical, logical, detail-oriented, and have excellent communication skills. Additionally, a commitment to ethical behaviour and working with integrity is highly valued.

How do I apply for a job at the AGSA?

What is the recruitment process like when applying to the AGSA?

The recruitment process may include an initial screening of resumes, a written or online assessment, an interview, and possible background checks.
